

Technical specification: Level 4 Role Simulation remotely invigilated exam

This document specifies the technical requirements needed for the remotely invigilated Level 4 Role Simulation exam. If you are sitting a Certificate Level or ICAEW CFAB exam, please find the relevant information here.

The Remote Invigilation system requires students to have both:

- · a Microsoft Windows computer or Apple Mac; and
- a smartphone.

Requirement	Minimum specification
Computer or other hardware specification	 Computer specification: Operating system: PC: The PC operating system should be a version supported by Microsoft. This is currently Windows 10 and 11. Mac: The Mac operating system should be a version supported by Apple. This is currently OS 12, 13, 14 and 15. Web browser: Latest version of Google Chrome. Webcam required. Computer/laptop, external or webcam microphone required, (microphones in headphones are not permitted). Audio required. ProctorExam Activity Sharing plug-in. We recommend using a monitor of 17" or larger for an optimum experience. If you are using a laptop you may also use an external monitor, but you must ensure you share the external monitor during your exam setup and that your laptop screen is off or mirrored, or you will be in breach of our exam rules. The exam software will work on smaller screens, but there will be less room to display the exam. Keyboard: wired or wireless. An external mouse is recommended.
	Mobile device:Operating system: Android: 8 or higher or Apple iOS 15.8 or higher.
	 Wi-Fi connected smartphone. The following apps need to be installed:

	 When you have opened the ProctorExam app, the video image must be clear for our invigilators to review your exam successfully. You can check this by opening the app and checking that the video quality looks clear. For Android users, the device requires access to the Google Play store.
Internet bandwidth	The minimum bandwidth required for the Remote Invigilation session is 3 Mbps. Wi-Fi is supported but we would recommend a fixed internet connection to your device. Tethering to a mobile phone/hot spot is not supported.
Software to be locally installed	Web browser: Latest version of Google Chrome The ProctorExam Activity Sharing plug-in will be prompted for when you go through your system checks ahead of your exam. You will need to give permission for the installation. Disable any Chrome extensions except the Proctor Exam Activity Sharing extension. On a mobile device the ProctorExam (iOS and Android) app must be installed.
