

#### TRUSTEE TREASURER

During the first half of the year, the Society incurred minimal operational costs.

Following the transition to the new format on July 1st, the Society currently holds a balance of approximately £100,000. £80,000 of the Society's funds are currently invested in a 3-month deposit earning an interest rate of 4.56%. The possibility of increasing the invested amount is under consideration.

The Society has not received any funding requests for activities to date. However, we are prepared to consider future funding proposals from the Essex Board or individual members in line with our established Reserves Policy.

The Society maintains a strong financial position with readily accessible funds to support approved member activities. We encourage the submission of funding proposals for initiatives that benefit our members.

A modest deficit of £116 was reported for the year due to minimal operational expenses.

The Board and members will collaborate to determine the optimal use of interest earned, including potential charitable contributions.
