REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE

YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2021

Review of the year

In 2021 the ICAEW Lancashire and South Lakeland (the Society) had a surplus of income over expenditure of £1,890 (2020: £3,222).

Activities during the year were severely curtailed as a result of COVID 19 with the annual dinner and face to face engagement once again being cancelled. Towards the end of the year we did host some in person activity. Total cost of all events was £1,110 (2020: £1,450) alongside centrally run CPD activity, the latter of which generated £430 (2020: £852) in contributions.

Total income including central contributions to support the running of the Society of £3,500 (2020: £3,500) was £4,718 (2020: £5,159). Total expenditure was £2,721 (2020: £1,784) resulting in a surplus before tax of £1,997 (2020: £3,375).

Statement of Committee Responsibilities

The Society's rules require accounts to be prepared for each financial year which give a true and fair view of its state of affairs at the end of the year and of its income and expenditure for the year.

In preparing these statements the Committee have due regard to:

- selecting suitable accounting policies and applying them consistently
- making judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent
- observing applicable accounting standards
- preparing the financial statements on a going concern basis

The Committee is also responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy the financial position of the Society and for safeguarding its assets.

6 Designated Funds held at 30 June 2001

At 30 June 2001 the Society held reserves of £41,189. These funds were designated at that time solely for use by the Society in the furtherance of its objectives locally. Following the regional reorganisations of District Societies at that time these funds were shown as "ring fenced" to ensure they were protected from any possible clawback at ICAEW head office level.

Since June 2001, the Society's activities have led to further retained reserves of £30,471 (2020: £28,581).

7 Related party transactions

Expenses of £400 (2020: £182) were paid or accrued in the accounts for the year relating to previous and outgoing Society presidents, reimbursing expenses for attendance at other District Chartered Accountant Society events. A contribution of £1,500 (2020: £1,500) was received from the ICAEW towards these costs.

Expenses of £nil (2020: £nil) were incurred by the Treasurer.
