REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE

YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2023

#### Review of the year

In 2023 the ICAEW Lancashire and South Lakeland (the society) had a surplus of income over expenditure of £65 (2022: deficit of income compared to expenditure of £7,584).

No activities took place during the year.

Total income was £1,975 (2022: £10,857). Total expenditure was £1,910 (2022: £18,441) resulting in a surplus after tax of £65 (2022: deficit of £7,584).

#### **Statement of Committee Responsibilities**

#### 6 Designated Funds held at 30 June 2001

At 30 June 2001 the Society held reserves of £41,189. These funds were designated at that time solely for use by the Society in the furtherance of its objectives locally. Following the regional reorganisations of District Societies at that time these funds were shown as "ring fenced" to ensure they were protected from any possible clawback at ICAEW head office level.

Since June 2001, the Society's activities have led to further retained reserves of £22,952 (2022: £22,887).

## 7 Related party transactions

Expenses of £nil (2022: £337) were paid or accrued in the accounts for the year relating to previous and outgoing society presidents, reimbursing expenses for attendance at other District Chartered Accountant Society events. A contribution of £nil (2022: £1,500) was received from the ICAEW towards these costs.

Expenses of £nil (2021: £nil) were incurred by the Treasurer.

## 8 Controlling party

The Society is controlled by the Committee on behalf of its members.
