

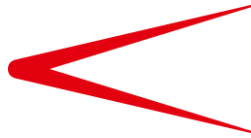

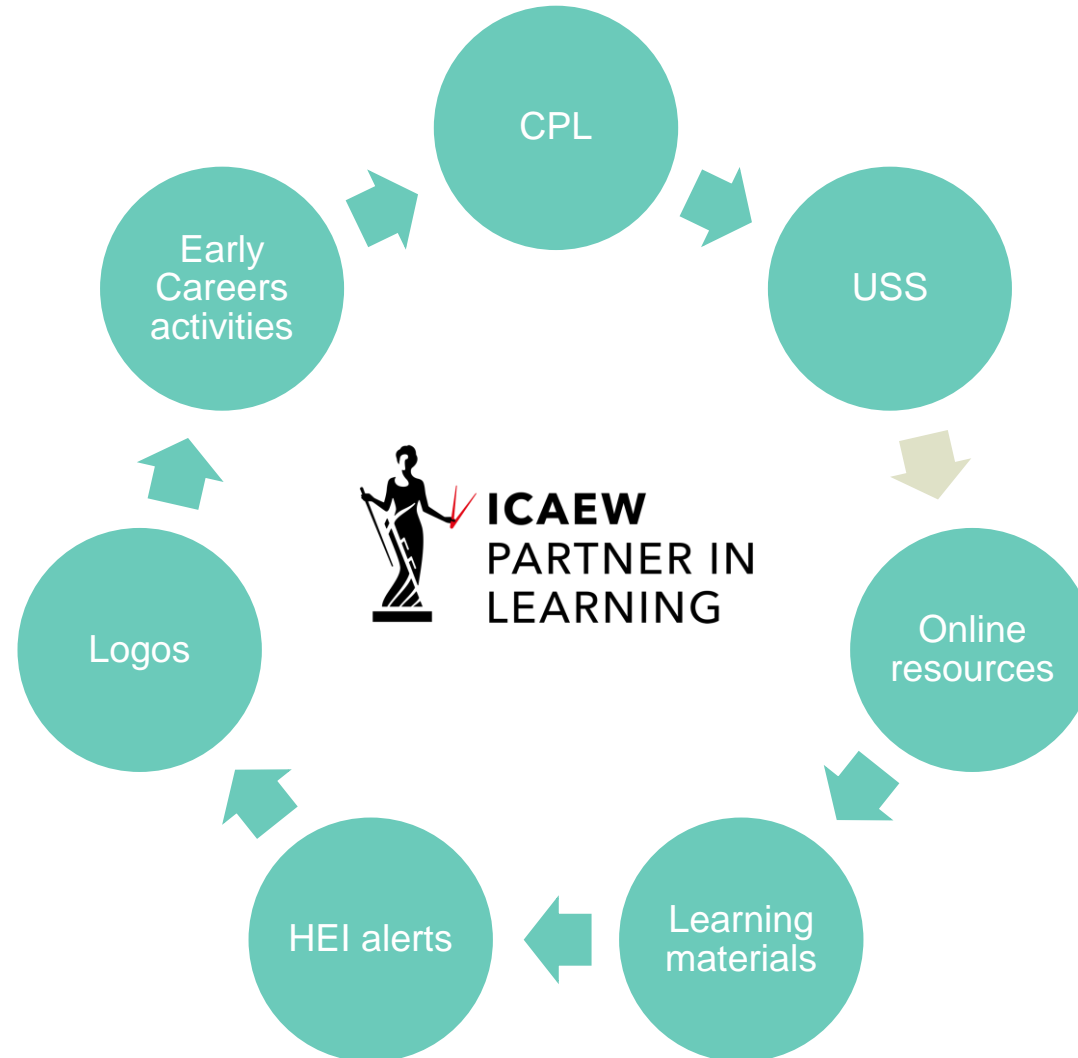

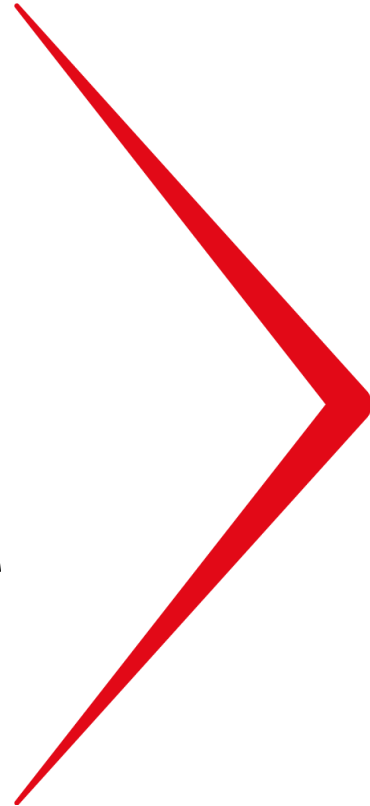
Alternative forms of assessment

If students cannot attend campus to take traditional invigilated exams what guidance have the FRC provided?

- 1. “RQBs which wish to do so, may grant credit for prior learning (CPL) where less than 50% of the marks have been gained by written examination for university degree modules assessed for the academic year 2021/2022. This extension is designed to take into account assessments related to the 2021/2022 academic year”.*
- 2. “It is definite that we will not be extending the concession and we will be returning to previous expectations. Since the lift of restrictions regarding social distancing etc. it seems that the concession on exams should no longer be required”.*
