


A history of Saffery Champness

2. George Augustus Cape was a founding member of the Institute of Accountants in London (1870), a member of its first Council and of the ICAEW's first Council.

3. H Croydsill was a member of the first Council of the Institute of Accountants in London (1870).
4. Armitage & Norton was founded by Charles Payne in 1868. The name Armitage & Norton was adopted in 1869. Other offices merged with Peat Marwick McLintock in 1987.
