- Jones, Crewdson & Co (Manchester) and Theo-dore B Jones & Co (Leeds) were both founded by Theodore Brooke Jones, the grandson of Edward Thomas Jones, who published his famous Jones's English system of book-keeping in 1706.
- Charles Henry Wade and Edwin Guthrie formed the Accountants' Incorporation Association in 1878. Both were petitioners for the Charter of the ICAEW and members of its first Council.
- 3. John Gordon was president of the ICAEW 1920-
- Ernest Evan Spicer and Ernest C Pegler are best remembered for their association with H Foulkes Lynch & Co and, in particular, their textbooks.
